

# SCOOTER INFORMATION


Ordinance 4390 regarding scooters, mopeds and motorized bicycles with 50 cc and below engines establishes new operational requirements within city limits. The new ordinance is effective Nov. 16, 2012.

Scooters, mopeds and motorized bicycles of 50 cc and below may not travel on roads with a posted speed of more than 35 miles per hour. Use the map below to assist your travels around Cape Girardeau.

To lawfully operate a scooter, moped or motorized bicycle within Cape Girardeau's city limits, the requirements listed at the right must be met. Violations of these requirements may result in a maximum fine of \$500 and 90 days in jail per incident.

## Requirements

- Valid driver license
- DOT-approved helmet
- Only one person; no passengers
- Insurance required; must carry proof
- Driver must remain seated
- Drive on streets with 35 mph or below speed limit
- Obey all road rules
- Maintain a working headlight, tail light and turn signals
