On Monday April 25, 2011 around 0415 hours, officers with the Cape Girardeau Police Department responded to 335 Christine, Shooters Gun Shop for an alarm sounding. Upon their arrival they found the side of the business had a large hole that appeared to have been made by a vehicle.

It was later determined that a newer model white Ford Flex registered to the "Friends of Peter Kinder" had been stolen and used in the burglary attempt at Shooters Gun Shop. That same vehicle was later located north of Cape Girardeau on Highway 177 where it had gotten stuck in the mud and then had been set on fire.

The Police Department is asking assistance identifying a Good Samaritan that had stopped to help push the vehicle out of the mud. It is not believed the Good Samaritan knew of any of the suspect's criminal activities.

Through the investigation, one suspect has been charged with Stealing of a Motor Vehicle (C Felony), Tampering 1<sup>st</sup> (C Felony), and Attempted Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> (D Felony). He is being held on a \$20,000 surety bond. He is identified as Adam Cromer, 21 years old, from Cape Girardeau.
