The Cape Girardeau Police Department has taken positive steps towards streamlining the process for citizens to obtain traffic accident reports 24 hours a day.

Like most law enforcement agencies across America, the Cape Girardeau Police Department has been pursuing an alternative to the servicing of report requests. Docview.us.com was found to be the most suitable and secure solution as a local accident repository for insurance and citizen report requests.

Docview.us.com charges a nominal convenience fee for this service, which is added to the cost of the report. Citizens can access the internet-based application by logging on to [www.docview.us.com](http://www.docview.us.com) or by visiting the Cape Girardeau Police Department's website which provides a direct link to the Department's Docview.us.com database. Citizens who do not wish to pay the convenience fee can still come to the Cape Girardeau Police Department during normal business hours and pay the normal report fee if they wish. Reports are accessible usually within five (5) days following an accident, excluding holidays and weekends.
