

Secure Your Load

Unsecured loads create litter and can cause accidents and injuries to motorists. Even if you're going a short distance and not driving on the highway, you are **required by law** to secure your load.

Good Load

Tie down with rope, bungee cords, netting or straps. Tie items directly to your vehicle including large items like appliances and garbage cans. Cover your load with a sturdy plastic tarp or net. Think about what would happen to your load if you had to stop suddenly or swerve. Put lighter weight things at the bottom of the load and don't overload your truck bed.



Bad Load

If your load is **NOT** inside a vehicle, covered with a tarp and/or tied down with ropes, straps or a net, you have an **UNSECURED LOAD**. City employees are required to issue you an unsecured load fee of \$25.00.
