## CITY OF CAPE GIRARDEAU RESIDENTIAL DUMPSTER PERMIT APPLICATION INFORMATION SHEET

Please read this information sheet in its entirety.

Conditions for dumpster placement:

- 1. The address of the lot on which the dumpster is located.
- 2. The name, address and telephone number of the owner of the lot.
- 3. A site plan accurately depicting the lot.
- 4. The location of any dumpster and associated fencing or screening on the lot and the location of the dumpster in relation to all abutting property.
- 5. A weekly schedule detailing the times and days of the week for cleaning the dumpster and lot, and maintaining the lot free of windblown litter and refuse.
- 6. The name of the owner of the lot or responsible party or designee responsible for overseeing the cleaning and maintenance of the lot.
- 7. The name, address, contact name and telephone number of the waste hauling company responsible for servicing the establishment or dumpster and the name, address, contact name, and telephone number of the person or entity signing the contract with the waste hauling company.
- 8. Sec. 22-52. Dumpster.
  - (d) Residential dumpster permit. Dumpster may initially be placed on the residential lot containing three (3) or fewer dwelling units for a maximum of thirty (30) days. An extension may be requested for a valid reason for a period of thirty (30) days. All dumpsters placed on lots containing three (3) or fewer dwelling units shall be maintained and serviced so that refuse does not overflow. The resident, property owner, and the dumpster company are all responsible persons under this section. (Ord. No. 4948, art. 2, 3-20-17)
