**CITY OF CAPE GIRARDEAU  
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INFORMATION SHEET**

The City of Cape Girardeau Code of Ordinances, Section 30-206(i) requires a favorable vote by two-thirds (2/3) of the City Council in order to pass a zoning amendment in instances where the City has received a protest petition signed by at least thirty (30) percent of the owners of property within one hundred eighty-five (185) feet of the zoning district boundary proposed to be amended. In order for a property to be counted in the thirty (30) percent requirement, all owners of the property must sign the protest petition. For example, if a property is owned by a husband and wife, both spouses must sign the petition. Each signature on the petition must be acknowledged by a Notary Public in order to be counted. The petition must be filed in the City Clerk's Office at City Hall, 401 Independence Street, no later than 5 p.m. on the Wednesday preceding the City Council public hearing on the proposed zoning amendment. The City Clerk will forward the petition to the Planning Services Division to verify that the protest petition meets the requirements. If the petition does not meet the requirements, Planning staff will call the primary contact listed on the petition.
