Giboney Houck his wife who are personally known to me, appeared before me, William Bonney a Notary Public, within and for the County of Washington, State of Missouri, and acknowledge the annexed map and Plat of Subdivision of Out Lot 47 - Survey 2199, to be their act and deed, and that they have laid out the said Out Lot 47 into Lots and Blocks, of the size & dimension on said Plat more particularly set out & described & numbered; Said Lots & Blocks as thereon specified; that they have laid out Giboney Avenue 80 feet wide; and College, Elm - Walnut & Maple Streets 60 feet wide, as on said Plat set out & added 10 feet to the width of Sprigg Street on the East side of said Street; and that the Alleys on said Plat marked, are 20 feet wide.
