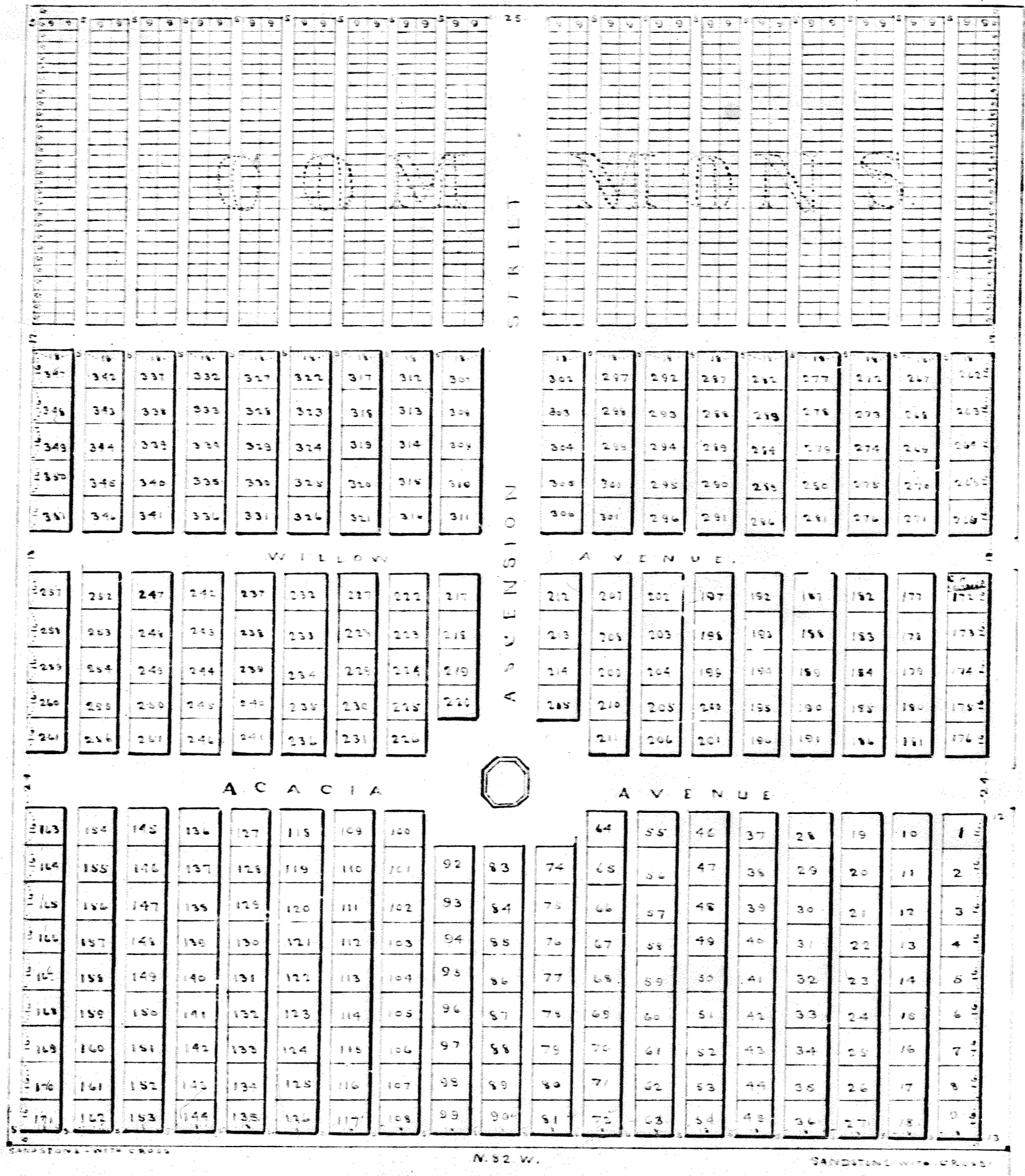


New City Cemetery



This Cemetery was laid out on the South End of Lot 18 of Walker's Subdivision of Out Lot 66 of U.S. Survey 2194 in Township 31, Range 14 in Cape Girardeau County, Missouri; February 1882, under the direction of Geo. H. Cramer, Mayor, and W. F. Regenhardt, W. V. Leach and Herman Vogelzang, Councilmen, by James Parsons, Surveyor. The lot corners are all marked with bricks. Scale: 50ft to 1 inch.

 Know all men by these presents, that George H. Cramer Mayor of the City of Cape Girardeau, in accordance with the provisions of ordinance No. 359, entitled "An Ordinance establishing and regulating cemeteries, and prescribing the duties of the bestor thereof." Approved April 20th 1882, do hereby acknowledge and declare that the plan made, to be a true representation of the New City Cemetery, its lots, streets, walks, and subdivisions as shown by the names and numbers thereon, for the uses and purposes in said ordinance, and in said plat set out and designated. In Testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and official signature, and have caused the same to be attested by the City Register, and the seal of the City to be thereto affixed; this 27th day of June 1882.
