

“OPERATION RESUME PLAY” Cape Splash – Phase IA

General Policies:

- Morning session from 11:00am-2:00pm.
- Disinfecting Hour from 2:00pm-3:00pm for sanitizing.
- Afternoon session from 3:00pm-6:00pm.
- Cost will be \$7 per person (adults & children \$7, under 12 months is free) per session.
- Each session will have 50% of total occupancy or 500 people, plus season pass holders.
- River walking and Preschool Playtime proceed with limited capacity of 100 (River Walking) 60 (Preschool Playtime).
- Customers and spectators must maintain six foot social distancing at all times.
- Increased signage encouraging social distancing and proper sanitation.
- Staff will make hourly social distancing and proper sanitation reminder announcements over the PA system.
- Staff and customer interactions will be limited and will follow social distancing.
 - Floor tape will be used from the entrance gates to the front desk to mark six feet.

Main Entrance/Admissions:

- Will designate one way in and one way out to monitor attendance.
- Will mark X's on floor to outline social distancing for customers.
- Sneeze Guard at front desk to protect customers and patrons.
- Hand Sanitizer station at entrance to building and breezeway.
- Season Pass Holders scan themselves in.
- Slide wristbands will still be issued. Parents will be responsible for handling wristbands.

Sanitation/Equipment:

- Staff will sanitize bathrooms and counters hourly or as needed in addition to the 2:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. sanitizing hour.
- Disinfect locker keys after every use.
- Wipe hand Rails every 30 minutes and in between sessions.

Concessions/Dining Area:

- Customers must maintain six foot social distancing at all times.
- Spread picnic tables out six feet.
- Put down markers on the floor.
- Extend the lines –marking social distancing.

Seating/Gazebos/Capacities:

- Set chairs and tables six feet apart on room set ups.

- Staff members will wipe down chairs after each session with disinfectant.
- Power wash chairs and tables each night.
- Schedule extra staff in Dining Terrace for cleanliness.
- Clean Birthday Party areas before and after each use.

Guard Shack/Tiki Huts

- Hand sanitizer stations by each shack.
- Social distancing marks on walk ways leading up to service area.
- First Aid station up front to prevent patrons from going to guard shack for first aid.

Locker Area:

- Keys will not be left in lockers-they will be returned to attendant who sanitizes at each use.
- Handles and lockers will be cleaned at the end of each session.
- As a reminder, we recommend customers do not bring phones or valuables into the waterpark.

Restrooms:

- Staff will disinfect rest room hourly.
- Flow will be one way entrance by changing area; one way exit through showers.

Slides:

- Put floor tape markers on the stairs at 6 feet apart.
- Matt Racer will be max of 2 people riding on outside lanes only.
- Will wipe hand rails as staff rotates into new position every 30 minutes.

Staff:

- Will social distance during breaks.
- Additional time between sessions will allow us time to transition staff in and out of facility.
- Will have shields on place at admission and concession areas.
- For rescues we have purchased additional BVM's (Bag Valve Masks).-No mouth to mouth resuscitation.
