ABOUT THE PROJECT

A Capaha Park master plan was created and in Phase I of the project, the aging Capaha Pool was torn down to make room for a new playground and shelter area. In 2015, Parks staff installed two new age appropriate play areas; and, with the help of a local carpenters union, constructed a new shelter overlooking the playground. In the next phases of the Capaha Park renovation, improvements were made to the existing Dan Cotner Amphitheatre. Future phases include the addition of new restrooms and a splash pad.
