ABOUT THE PROJECT

On May 29, 2010 the Cape Splash Family Aquatic Center opened to the public. The facility included a bathhouse, spray pad, water play structure, a 700 foot lazy river, and four water slides. In 2015, a three flume mat racer, single drop slide, and an open flume triple drop slide was installed for the thrill seeker. In 2017, an additional pavilion was created in the island of the lazy river, and a pirate ship play area was constructed. Many programs including, swimming lessons, fitness classes, special events, and adult swim days take place at the Cape Splash Family Aquatic Center to serve thousands of guests each summer.
