Kiwanis Park has received several additions and improvements since the 2008 Parks & Recreation Stormwater Tax Initiative passed. In 2016, the shelter three pavilion was renovated and the area received a new play structure with more accessible amenities. Shelter two was also torn down and replaced in 2016.
