

GOOD HOPE WATERSHED

STREET DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS

The area of Good Hope / Christine / Plaza Way has experienced severe street flooding for many years. This flooding interferes with emergency vehicle response. It also impacts the businesses in the area. The improvement project will replace a mix of smaller pipe sizes with a 60-inch pipe along Good Hope from Spring Street directly to the Walker Branch Creek at Kingshighway. The project will install additional inlets along the street. The project will also resolve a culvert problem on Christine near the NAPA Auto Parts building. The improvements will substantially reduce the occurrence of flooding in the area. The estimated cost for the project is \$3.5 million. This project will include street pavement repairs in the work area. There will also be a need to address a number of underground utility conflicts to install the new drain pipes.
