Call to Order

Chairman McClanahan called the meeting to order at 7:00 a.m.

The notes from the previous meeting stood approved as submitted.

Discussion of Projects for TTF 5 Proposed Project List

Mrs. Brunke informed the group that MoDOT will be conducting an assessment of the Big Bend Road/Sloan Creek bridge and will make a recommendation to the City on whether it should be repaired vs. replaced. Mr. Voss requested that staff ask MoDOT for cost data for similar projects in the past 5 years once a decision has been made on the scope of the project.

The group discussed Independence Street between Gordonville Road/East Rodney Drive and Broadview Street. This corridor is heavily used and becomes congested at peak traffic times. Mrs. Brunke stated that the City and the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission are in the process of executing an STP-Urban Program Agreement which will provide grant funding for a traffic study of the Independence/Gordonville/East Rodney intersection as well as design and construction. Mr. Voss asked if the traffic study can also include the corridor down to Broadview. He added that there appear to be several issues with the corridor, but an accurate problem statement needs to be developed in order to proceed. Mrs. Brunke agreed to provide accident data for this corridor as well as the East Cape Rock Drive/Country Club Drive/Main Street intersection. She will also prepare a cost estimate for the corridor once the scope of the project has been established.

Mr. Shrimplin presented a pair of project scoring tools that staff created based on the examples reviewed at the previous meeting. One of the scoring tools was for road and bridge projects; the other was for bicycle and pedestrian projects. The group made some minor changes to the tools and proceeded with scoring the projects initially selected for the proposed project list.

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Other Business

Ms. Hood informed the group that the TTF 5 Subcommittee meeting with the City Council is proposed for November 6th or 11th.

Mr. Glenn reminded the group that the Chamber of Commerce Transportation Committee has requested a preview of the proposed project list once it is completed.

The next meeting was scheduled for September 29, 2014 at 7:00 a.m. in the Development Services Conference Room at City Hall.
