The Cape Girardeau Police Department announced today the arrest of Evan Johnson Jr. of Cape Girardeau who is charged with the class B Felony of attempted robbery and armed criminal action with a bond of \$50,000 surety.

These charges stem from an attempted robbery that occurred back on November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2013 near the intersection of Bloomfield and Hanover Street. The attempted robbery occurred when two subjects discussed buying an Xbox from the victim. One of the subjects pulled out a gun and the other tried to punch the victim and take his Xbox. When the victim fled he heard two gunshots. One of those shots grazed his left calf causing a minor injury. The shooter in this incident is not in custody.
