On Thursday February 7th, 2013 at approximately 11:45 P.M. officers of the Cape Girardeau Police Department were dispatched to 401 South Pacific in reference to shots being fired. A short time after arriving on scene officers observed a man hiding in an alleyway. When officers approached the man and identified themselves as police officers the subject fled but was caught and taken into custody. At 401 South Pacific officers discovered that there were two victims that had been shot multiple times. Medical personnel were called but victims, a 43 year old male and a 39 year old female, were declared deceased by Cape Girardeau County Coroner John Clifton.

The Cape Girardeau/Bollinger County Major Case Squad was activated and is investigating. Charges will be applied for with the Cape Girardeau County Prosecuting Attorney's Office. The victims' names have not been released pending notification of the next of kin.
