With regard to the fatal shooting of Mr. Quinton David Combs on Sunday, November 15, 2015, Cape Girardeau/Bollinger County Major Case Squad has been disbanded per the 72-hour standard activation period.

A person of interest has been identified in this case and investigators are aggressively pursuing this lead.

During the course of this investigation, information was developed that up to sixty individuals were present in the area at the time of the shooting. To this date, not one of those individuals has called in with information.

Through tips and multiple sources of information, witnesses to the murder were identified. These witnesses were exhaustively interviewed; many of them multiple times, and they refused to cooperate.
