On Monday, June 29, 2015, the Cape Girardeau Police Department received a report of a shooting. The first 911 call came in at 2:46 PM. The incident occurred at 401 South Hanover. The victim was reportedly on the porch when a vehicle passed by. Several gunshots were reportedly fired from the vehicle. The female victim, who is a Cape Girardeau resident, was struck once in her head. No other subjects were injured. The victim was transported to a local hospital with a serious injury. The gunshots are reported to have come from an "SUV"-type vehicle.

This case is currently being investigated by the Cape Girardeau/Bollinger County Major Case Squad.
